



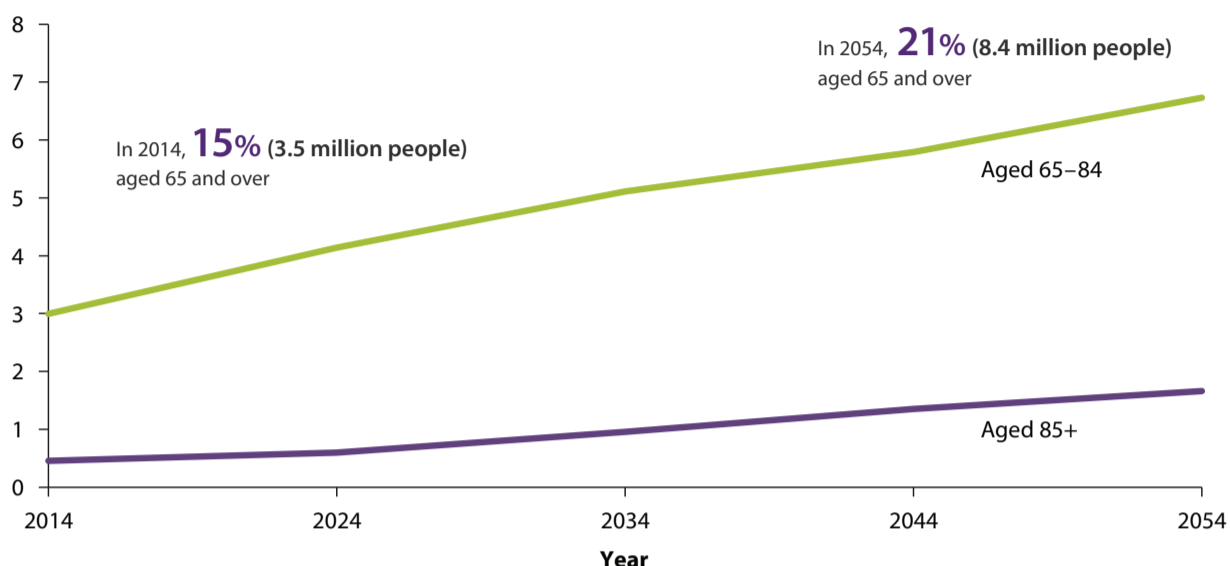

Number (millions)

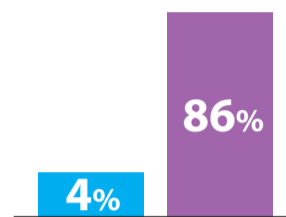


People with disability

Changing workforce

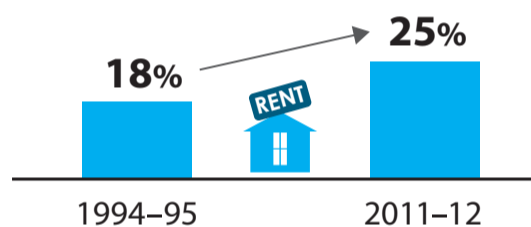
Between 1992 and 2014, the labour force participation rate has changed.



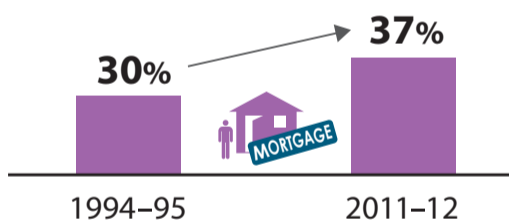
Men retire, on average, at 58 and women at 50. While this has changed little for men since 2004-05, it has increased from 47 years for women.

Home ownership

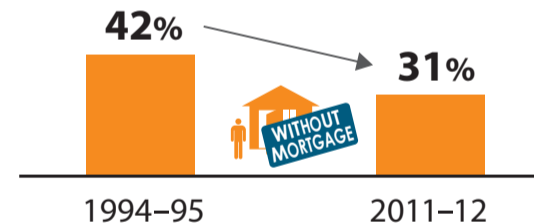
The proportion of households renting



The proportion of households with a mortgage

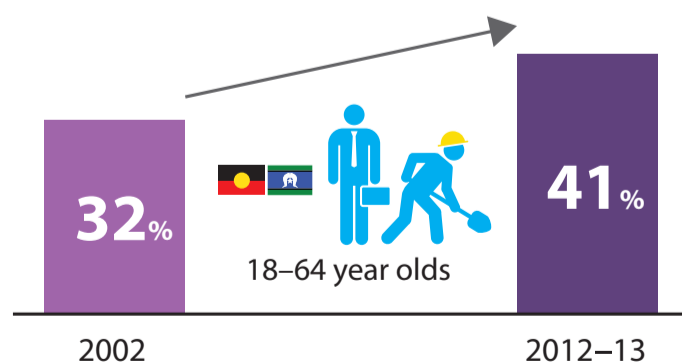


The proportion of households without a mortgage

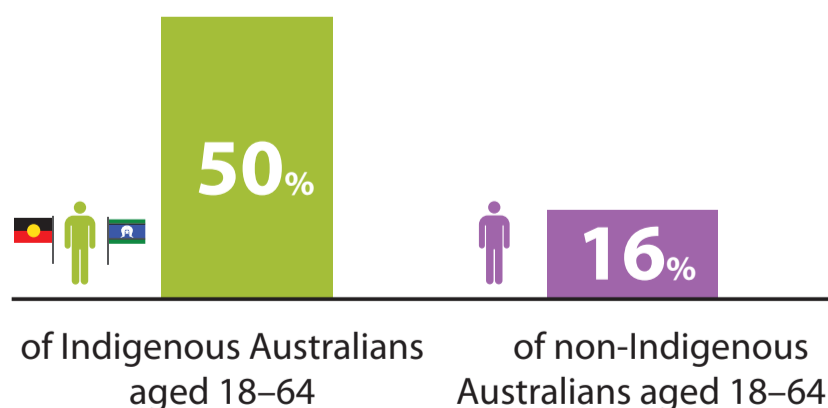


Indigenous Australians
