### Validata™ is ready to receive September 2024 extracts

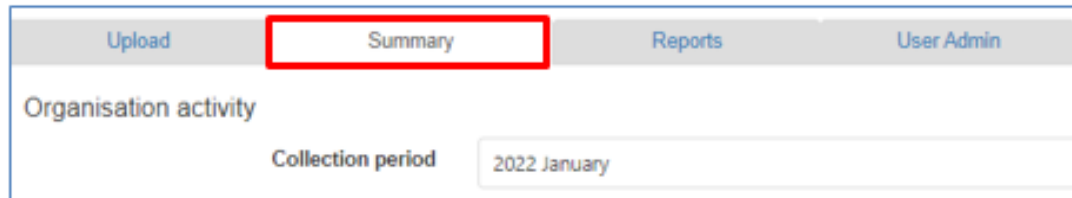
If your August 2024 extract has been submitted to Validata™, you can now upload and submit your September 2024 extract. Please remember to click the “Submit” button after your extract has been validated and contains zero critical errors.



### Important information in Validata™ - manager contact details

It is important that the manager contact details for each agency are reviewed and updated on a regular basis. The AIHW uses this information to authorise new users who are seeking access to Validata™.

Manager details for each agency can be found on the **Summary** tab in Validata™.

### Confidentiality of client information

The AIHW does not collect, nor distribute, any identifiable information regarding SHS clients or unassisted persons. The AIHW only collects responses to questions in SHIP that are shown in **bold text**. All other questions that are in ordinary font are for the benefit and use of agency staff.



To ensure the confidentiality of clients, SHIP creates an **Alpha Code** for each client, which is collected by AIHW instead of their full name. The **Alpha Code** is made up of the **2nd and 3rd letters** of a client's first name, and the **2nd, 3rd and 5th letters** of their family name. This code then forms a part of a statistical linkage key, which is used to count and report the number of clients receiving services.

When entering client details in SHIP, it is important to use your client's formal name as stated on their Medicare or Centrelink card. Recording nicknames or a person's alias increases the likelihood of creating duplicate client records.
